The following are the By-Law changes.

#1

OLD BY LAW

Section 6.5 The Secretary of the Aerie shall serve as Secretary of the Board of Trustees of this Aerie, with the approval of the Board of Trustees, and receive for such services of the compensation as provided in these same By-Laws.

NEW BY-LAW

Section 6.5 The Secretary of the Aerie shall serve a Secretary of the Board of Trustees of this Aerie, with the approval of the Board of Trustees, and receive for such services of the compensation as provided in these same By-Laws. **Secretary may serve on the board of trustees if elected by the Aerie membership.**

OLD BY-LAW

Section 9.8 The salary of all employees (manager, janitor, bartenders and waitresses) shall be fixed by the Board of Trustees.

NEW BY-LAW

Section 9.8 The salary of all employees (manager, janitor, bartenders and waitresses) shall be fixed by the Board of Trustees, **with the approval of the Aerie, in accordance with Union contract.**

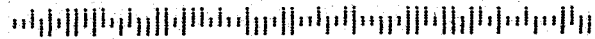
